"The purpose of the Student Services, coordinator of mental health supports position is to carry out the mission and priorities of the both the district and department by leading, developing, and coordinating professional learning activities related to mental and behavioral health and supports in service of our students and school community. The role of the coordinator of mental health supports is to develop models of practice that increase access to relevant and effective mental / behavioral health services in schools. The coordinator creates, produces, directs, and facilitates the learning of key stakeholders such as parents / guardians, central office, and school-based staff for the purpose of supporting implementation of the district's behavior education / mental health framework, the Behavior Education Plan and promoting social and emotional wellness. The coordinator leads a team of mental and behavior specialists who provide technical assistance, professional development, and support to school staff regarding the social / emotional needs of students. Further, the coordinator is a resource in collaboratively developing school support plans with central office personnel, principal and/or school-based leadership team members in order to realize their ambitious school improvement plan goals."
