Preparing for ICD-10

Prepare for the transition to ICD-10. ICD-10 codes are four times longer thanICD-9 codes and more complicated. The crosswalk of the ICD-9 code set to ICD-10 is also more complicated. This training is for provider or payer staff responsible for diagnosing, coding or submitting claims for payment or processing. Two sessions are offered: one for clinical staff and one for financial and claims staff.

Instructor Vince Joyce is an authority on assisting behavioral healthcare providers and payers with claims management, data analysis and software system implementation. As president of e3 Informatics, he has worked extensively with N.C. Medicaid and IPRS. He has helped providers and MCOs prepare for ICD-10 and has presented transition trainings at statewide conferences, including NC TIDE.

- How to recognize challenges of cross walking DSM-V and ICD-9 to ICD-10
- To understand software system changes to accommodate ICD-10
- How to select testing strategies to ensure claim systems are ready for ICD-10
- To use ICD-10 resources like the CMS general equivalence mappings (GEMS), the ICD-10 crosswalks in the DSM-V manual and several ICD-10 websites
