

Attention Behavioral Health Providers Important ANTIPSYCHOTIC PDL changes go into effect June 5, 2015

The NC Medicaid Outpatient Pharmacy Program will implement changes to the <u>antipsychotic</u> portion of the Preferred Drug List (PDL) on Friday, June 5, 2015.

Starting on June 5, 2015, antipsychotics will have preferred and non-preferred agents listed on the PDL. Please note that trial and failure of only one preferred agent is required for antipsychotic medications in order to request a non-preferred agent. "Smart PA" will review claims for the most recent 24 months to determine if patients meet this criteria already.
