Payment Policy

- Your payment for class is due at the first class or session of the cycle. Payments can be made using cash, check or credit card. Returned checks will be assessed a \$30 fee.
- Income-based assistance is available to those who qualify. Eligibility is determined
 using a sliding fee scale. If you would like to be considered for assistance, you may fill
 out an application and provide proof of income, such as a current tax return or pay stub.
 You may reapply for assistance each September prior to starting the fall cycle.
- Pay it forward! As a non-profit organization, the rates we charge for classes do not
 cover our programming costs. We rely heavily on the generosity of sponsors and
 individuals to provide music therapy in our community. If you would like to contribute to

Health Guidelines

• The Board of Health considers the following signs to indicate communicable disease/illness: vomiting, fever over 100 degrees, diarrhea, sore throat, rash/swelling, red or running eyes. Please be sure your student is symptom free for 24 hours before resuming programs. Please note that if you bring your student to program and he/she exhibits any of the above symptoms, it is at the staff's discretion to send him/her home in order to protect themselves and our other clients from infectious illness.
