



## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

We recommend that you register promptly as class sizes are limited. Classes with inadequate enrollment will be cancelled two days before the start date and you will be notified. Registration may be completed in person or via email, phone, or fax and the forms can be found on our website: www.craftguildofdallas.com.

Full payment is due upon enrollment. The tution, minus a \$25 administrative fee, will be reimbursed if the enrollee cancels more than 23 days before the first day of the class or workshop. Only credits towards future classes or workshops may be given to an enrollee who withdraws 7 days or less before the start date of the class or workshop. A Craft Guild membership is required for classes but not workshops. Annual individual membership is \$60 and is pro-rated throughout the year. Memberships are non-refundable.

An Addison Building Fee (ABF) will apply to each class and workshop. The ABF is calculated per hour of workshop or class: \$1/hour; \$0.50/hour for seniors, ages 60+.

Make-up classes are not guaranteed for missed classes and are at the discretion of the instructor. Only if the missed class is the last class of the session may it be made up in the next session. Otherwise, missed classes cannot be carried over to the next session. Please note, supplies are not included in the tuition. Information about supplies will be provided upon registration and during the first class.

# **CLAY**

Our classes cover the entire process of working with clay: raw material, glazing, and firing in our reduction, salt, and raku kilns. Our spacious clay studio includes wheels, a glaze room, and bisque kiln room. The clay department is a community-based environment and students are encouraged to get involved in every aspect of working in the studio. Master Workshops are taught by visiting professionals and present unique opportunities to learn from top artists in the field. Open labs enable students to continue their work outside of class and are available to all registered clay students. Tuition covers glaze materials and kiln firings; clay and tools are available for purchase in the studio.

BOOK, PAPER, LEATHER, AND FIBER ARTS

The bookbinding studio is fully equipped with the tools, machinery, and supplies that have been used by handbookbinders for centuries. We teach basic to advanced techniques and stuctures, from simple paper covered blank journals to fine bindings in leather and book restoration. Printing classes have a 19th century iron hand press and fonts of moveable type available for their use. Fiber arts offerings include felting, surface design, and dyeing techniques for artists of all levels. We now offer leather working classes and workshops. Small class sizes ensure individual instruction and attention.

# **GLASS**

Under expert instruction, students work in a studio fully equipped for lampworking, fused glass, and stained glass. Lampworking students work in soft glass and borosilicate, creating colorful beads and marbles, wearable pendants, and small vessels. Fusing and stained glass students learn traditional and modern techniques to create unique art glass pieces. Master Workshops are taught by visiting professionals and present unique opportunities to learn from top artists in the field. Open labs enable students to continue their work outside of class time and are available to experienced glass students currently enrolled in class.
