The Future Physician Leaders (FPL) program is a lifelong mentorship program for pre-medical high school and undergraduate students specifically from the Coachella Valley, Riverside-San Bernardino, and Temecula region. For seven weeks in the summer, students participate in a leadership lecture series, community health project, and physician shadowing.

- Strong interest in the health professions and science

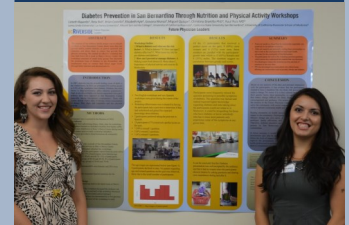
