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Natomas Schools Foundation Announces Scholarships for Local Students

The Natomas Schools Foundation (NSF) is proud to announce its annual scholarship program. In 2016 the NSF will be offering at least \$6,000 in scholarships to high school and post-high school students who reside(d) and attend(ed) high school within the boundaries of the Natomas Unified School District. We are offering three (3) scholarships of \$1,000 each for current high school seniors and six (6) scholarships of \$500.

Applicant Requirements:

- Reside(d) <u>and</u> attend(ed) high school within the boundaries of the Natomas Unified School District:
- 50 hours or more of volunteer/community service, and/or formal employment, and/or service to school through a formal club or organization during the last two years;
- Three (3) letters of reference from any of the following: counselor, teacher, coach, employer, volunteer leader, religious leader and/or neighbor;
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher;
- Short essay of 300-500 words describing what you learned from volunteer or employment experiences and how you think those lessons will help you in the future.

Applications are due March 31, 2016.

Decisions will be announced by May 15, 2016.

Awards can be used towards educational expenses in accredited four-year or twoyear colleges or in a trade school.
