Hospice volunteers are a specialized group of individuals who go through 30 hours of training that is accredited by the Hospice Palliative Care of Ontario. The training equips all volunteers with the proper communication, support and assistance that is required when caring for hospice clients, families and caregivers. All volunteers are expected to visit their client once a week for 2-4 hours.
