The Market Manager supervises four support staff members.

The Hollywood Farmers' Market was founded in 1991 as part of the Hollywood Revitalization effort, and has since grown to be one of the most popular and respected Farmers' Markets in the City of Los Angeles and the State of California. The successful candidate for the position of Manager will have at least three years of experience managing a Certified Farmers' Market (strong preference will be given to California-based candidates,) a strong working knowledge of the direct marketing laws that govern farmers' markets in the State, and an unwavering respect and commitment to the integrity of farmers markets. Further preference will be given to a/the candidate with experience managing a market with more than 50 vendors.

The Hollywood Farmers' Market Manager works closely with and coordinates with farmers, food purveyors, artisans, community organizations, government agencies, volunteers and neighborhood constituents, in order to insure a smooth and effective and management and promotion of the weekly. Every Sunday, rain or shine, the Hollywood Farmers' Market hosts approximately 160 vendors and 10,000 customers. The Market is a year-round entity and is open from 8am-1pm.

The position of Manager reports to and is supervised by SEE-LA's Executive Director.

- Proven experience managing a California Certified Farmers' Market(s), agriculture, nutrition, food assistance programs, community outreach and program development;
- A minimum of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university;
- Experience with farmers' market "Load Lists" is preferred as well as experience and ability to maintain administrative records, prepare market reports, and handle cash and receipts;

- Responsible for overseeing the physical set-up and take-down of market, including Street Closure(s);
- Responsible for managing and directing farmers/vendors including assigning vendor spaces (weekly mapping of the Market,) enforcing market rules and other pertinent State/County/City laws and regulations;
- Ensure that the market site is well-maintained;
- Ability to handle emergencies, complaints, feuds and farmers/vendor and customer requests;
- Collect cash, credits, fees and load lists;
- Requires lifting, carrying or handling of heavy objects (up to 50 pounds);
- Responsible for maintaining an effective customer assistance information center, assuring good public relations and encouraging an effective volunteer service;
- Manage market events, promotion, social media channels and other tasks as required;
