Kaeja d'Dance welcomes residents and families of Seaton Village, situated between Dupont/Bloor and Bathurst/Christie, to partake in **Porch View Dances 2016**, a public-participatory community dance festival presented in partnership with St Alban's Boys' & Girls' Club and a family of other supporters in mid-July 2016. Conceived by Karen Kaeja and developed with Allen Kaeja, *Porch View Dances (PVD)* has become a summer event that attracts spectators from across Ontario. In the manner of a guided neighbourhood tour, a tour guide leads audiences from house to house, through the streets, to witness the Porch View Dances. The tour culminates in an audience inclusive *Flock Landing* in Vermont Square Park.
