

## **NEW! Three SOU Courses Pre-approved for Auditing**

Did you know? OLLI members aged 65+ who have lived in Oregon for one year are eligible to audit SOU classes at no cost, with instructor approval.

As a new OLLI member benefit, OLLI's Curriculum Committee has obtained pre-approval for OLLI members to audit these three SOU courses:

### **NAS 390 - Introduction to the Nine Tribes of Oregon**

Provides an introductory overview of the nine federally recognized tribes of Oregon. Explores the origins and transitions from pre-contact to contemporary. Discussion of the Native perspective on the development of Oregon and her inhabitants. Class meets 1:30 pm to 3:20 pm, Tuesdays and Thursdays, from Sept. 28 to Dec. 11, in Taylor Hall room 227. Five seats available.

### **SOAN 464 - Cultural Rights**

Explores issues related to the rights of individuals and groups to practice culture and participate in cultural community. Discusses cultural rights as a critical concept in public policy and practice. Examines how groups assert cultural uniqueness, how dominant institutions respond to cultural diversity, and how cultural rights are limited. Class meets 10:30 am to 12:20 pm on Mondays and Wednesdays, Sept. 28 to Dec. 11, in Taylor Hall room 229. Four seats available.

### **TA 462 - Advanced Costume Design**

Expands the skills developed in costume design. Students generate a professional portfolio through further investigation of play interpretation, character analysis, research challenges, and intensive drawing and painting. NOTE: OLLI auditing students will be expected to do same projects as SOU students. Class meets 10:30 am to 12:20 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays, Sept. 28 to Dec. 11, in the Cascade Complex, room 109. Five seats available.

To audit one or more of these courses, the first step is to stop by the OLLI office at the Campbell Center and pick up an auditing form. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. First come, first served. You must pick up the form in person; you cannot register to audit these courses via telephone or email.

Please note that SOU classes start Monday, Sept 28. As an auditing student, you do not have to attend the first class (attendance is always optional), and you do not have to inform the OLLI office if you will miss a class or decide to drop the class at a later date.
