



Dr Allan Boesak is professor of theology at Christian Theological Seminary and the Desmond Tutu Chair of Peace, Global Justice and Reconciliation Studies. Born in South Africa, his early activism and service led to international recognition as an influential leader in the fight against apartheid. During the 1980s he worked alongside Desmond Tutu and Nelson Mandela to lead efforts against apartheid and promote reconciliation.

He has served as chair, advisor and founder of various boards and institutions, including serving as an advisor to the World Council of Churches and the Apartheid Commission of the United Nations. He has preached, lectured and taught in many settings, has written 17 books, and has been awarded numerous honors and awards in recognition of his leadership on humanitarian, reconciliation, social justice and theological leadership.
