## LECTURER BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Stacy Suskauer is a research scientist at the Kennedy Krieger Institute, where she is director of Brain Injury Rehabilitation Programs, and is an associate professor of physical medicine and rehabilitation at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. She attended Duke University for her undergraduate and medical education. Dr. Suskauer completed a combined residency program in pediatrics and physical medicine and rehabilitation at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center and the University of Cincinnati. She joined the Kennedy Krieger Institute and Johns Hopkins for a pediatric rehabilitation research fellowship; she has been on the faculty of these institutions since 2007. Dr. Suskauer is board-certified in pediatrics and physical medicine and rehabilitation. She holds a subspecialty certification in pediatric rehabilitation medicine.
