2017 Conference Theme:

NASW-NM is seeking submissions for our 2017 Social Work Conference entitled: "Social Work in a Changing World: What's Identity Got to Do with It?" We are looking for topics addressing identity as it relates to the intersectionality of race, ethnicity, gender, sexuality, culture, age, religion, language, nativity, and location specific to our clients, communities, policies and our profession.

We are particularly looking for proposals that focus directly on the populations and cultures we serve in the Southwest. However all completed proposals will be reviewed and considered.

Criteria for Submission:

Each proposal will be rated on the basis of meeting the following criteria:

- 1. **Relevance to social work**. This is a conference focusing upon the social work profession.
- 2. **Innovative approach**. A focus upon new and emerging themes and interventions.
- 3. **Broad audience interest**. Participants of the conference come from varied settings, interests, and practices.
- 4. **Quality of proposal**. Incomplete, unedited, unprofessional, and/or hand-written proposals will not be reviewed.
- 5. **Real world application**. When possible or appropriate, proposals should have an applied focus.
- 6. Use of creative examples. The uses of case studies/examples and media are encouraged.
- 7. **Plan for audience interaction**. Proposals should seek the engagement of the audience, if and whenever appropriate.


Required Format:

The Submission Review Committee seeks high quality presentations and all submissions must include the following elements:

- 1. A completed Application Form.
- 2. A 150 word biography describing credentials, titles, and experience of all presenters and copresenters.
- 3. Three learning objectives.
- 4. A 250-500 word abstract including the purpose for, and content delivered in, your proposed session.
- 5. A 100-word summary describing your presentation for the Conference Program (if selected.)

Note: All pages of the Application must be typed and only completed applications will be reviewed. All communications from NASW-NM will go to the lead presenter who will be responsible for conveying information to co-presenters.

Selected proposals will be received one (1) free full conference registration and one (1) 50% off conference registration for a co-presenter.


