



2015 AIA Oklahoma Awards of Excellence Program

CALL FOR ENTRIES The purpose of the AIA Oklahoma Awards of Excellence Program is to increase the public awareness of architecture by recognizing outstanding projects, their architects and clients, to increase the public and client demand for quality design and to encourage the profession to pursue the highest standards of design.

CATEGORIES

- Architecture -- Commercial
- Architecture -- Residential
- Urban Design & Planning
- Interior Architecture
- Restoration/Rehabilitation/Adaptive Reuse
- 25 Year Award

ELIGIBILITY

Only AIA Oklahoma members in good standing may enter the Awards of Excellence Program. Eligible projects include any project built anywhere in the world or any project built in Oklahoma and designed by an AIA architect licensed to practice in Oklahoma at the time of the project's completion. Projects must have been completed after January 1, 2010, and prior to the deadline for receipt of submissions. An individual or firm may submit an unlimited number of entries for which authorship can be supported. Previously honored projects in local Chapter honor awards programs are eligible. Projects that have previously received regional or national AIA awards are not eligible. The 25 Year Award will be projects under the above criteria with a completion date between January 1, 1965 and January 1, 1990.

SCHEDULE

All submittals must be postmarked by dates listed below.

- Entry forms + fees submitted: Friday, June 19, 2015, 4:00 PM CDT
- Completed entries delivered to the AIA Oklahoma office: Monday, August 31, 2015, 4:00 PM CDT
- Design awards program/ceremony: Thursday, November 5, 2015, 6:00 p.m.

FEES

An entry fee of \$150 is required for each project submitted. Entrants may complete an entry form and pay by credit card at www.aiaok.org or should complete the attached entry form and send it with a check payable to: AIA Oklahoma, 6301 Waterford Blvd., Suite 105, Oklahoma City, OK 73118.

CEREMONY

The reception, banquet and awards ceremony will be held on Thursday, November 5, 2015, at the ConocoPhillips OSU Alumni Center, Stillwater, Oklahoma, in conjunction with the AIA Oklahoma Annual Convention.

JURORS

The jury is comprised of four respected architects, all of whom have extensive experience in the jury process.

AWARDS

The method of selection and number of awards presented shall be at the discretion of the 2015 AIA Oklahoma Awards of Excellence Jury.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

Entrants will be sent an information packet for each entry. These packets will be issued no later than Friday, June 26, 2015. Packets will contain detailed submission requirements, your registration number and other descriptive information.

All entries must include:

- A Power Point presentation derived from a template provided by AIA Oklahoma for each entrant to follow. The template includes up to 10 slides depicting the project in a minimum of four photographs, two drawings and one text slide.
- Identification forms, which will be provided to entrants in Word format.
- Up to six high resolution project images (300 dpi, 8X10 size), a selection of which may be used during the Awards Ceremony and/or for publication and publicity.
- Submittal instructions will be forwarded to entrants upon receipt of entry forms with payment.
- Submittal requirements will be further detailed at that time.

It will be the entrant's responsibility to ensure that submissions are cleared for release by AIA Oklahoma. Material submitted should not be restricted against publication in connection with the AIA Oklahoma Design Awards Program and any publicity thereafter.
