Sponsored by the College Hill Neighborhood Association in partnership with The City of Easton, Northampton County, and Lafayette College

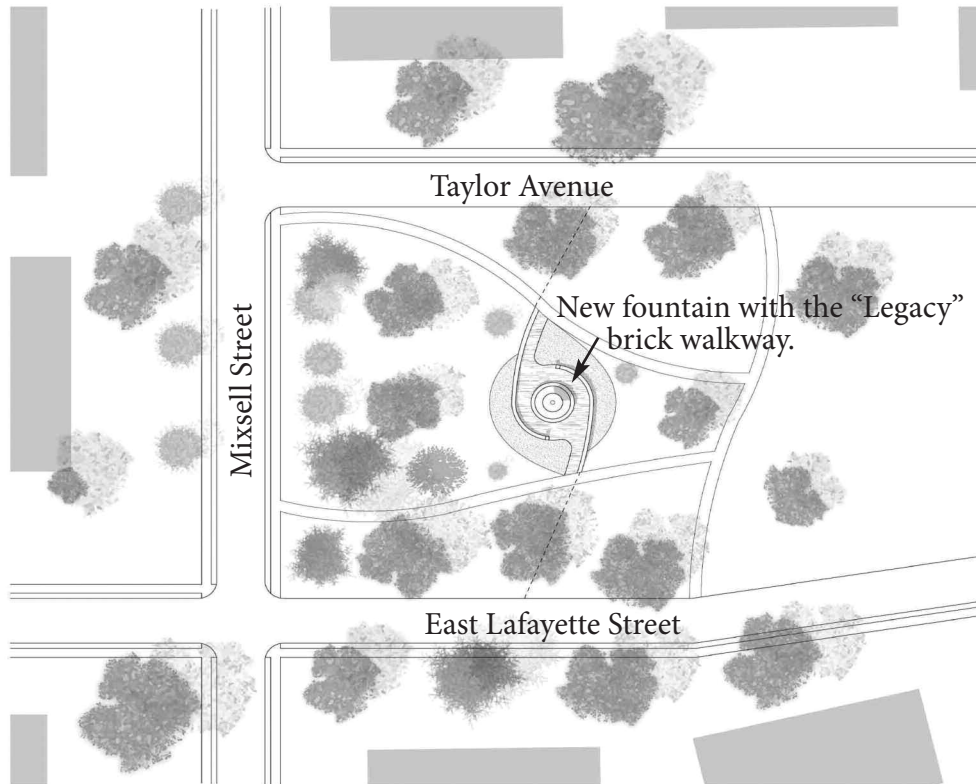


- When the fountain fell into disrepair, it was put into storage, where it became damaged and rusted during the Depression. The cast-iron fountain met a noble end as it was melted down for munitions during World War II.
- A plaque at the site of the new fountain will commemorate the original historic fountain in perpetuity.

Be a part of Easton's NEW history. Purchase a brick for the fountain walkway engraved with your personalized inscription.

A watered-down history of the fountain.

- The new fountain will pay historical homage to the original fountain that once was the centerpiece of Centre Square in downtown Easton.
- In 1899, the fountain was dismantled to make way for the Soldiers and Sailors Monument honoring Civil War veterans. The fountain was moved to College Hill on land owned by David Nevin, a Lafayette College alumnus and former mayor of Easton.

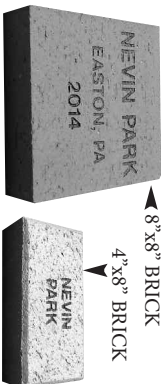
