

#### A Message from Pastor Howell

"Who has believed what they heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? For He grew up before Him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; He had no form or majesty that we should look at Him, and no beauty that we should desire Him. He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces He was despised and we esteemed Him not. Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions; He was crushed for our iniquities; upon Him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with His stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:1-5

Of course, the prophecy from Isaiah was fulfilled in and through the Messiah, Jesus Christ. As we rapidly approach Easter, we are reminded that Jesus Christ's sacrificial death on the cross was a demonstration of God's great love for sinners like us. Because of Jesus' death, burial, and Resurrection, we not only have our transgressions and iniquities — our sins — forgiven and covered, but we have peace with God. As Paul reiterates in Colossians 1:19-20

"For in Him (Jesus) all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through Him (Jesus) to reconcile to Himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of the cross."

It is only by the blood of the cross that we can have peace with God. And, it is only as we place our faith and trust in Jesus Christ — and Christ alone — that we can experience the peace of God in our lives. That may not be what people want to hear today, but it is what people need to hear. In a culture — including many within Christianity — that would rather not talk about the blood of Jesus, the Church of Jesus Christ simply has no other message to proclaim but the cross and the empty tomb!

As we prepare for Easter, we have an opportunity to share a counter-cultural message that has power and that can transform lives. But, we must be willing to share the message. We must be willing to share the message with our family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors. We must be willing to share the message with all kinds of people, including all kinds of sinners, both the good kind and the bad kind. We must be willing to share the message when it is inconvenient. We must be willing to share the message when it will be rejected. We must be willing to share the message when it will be mocked and ridiculed. We must, at the end of the day, simply be willing to share the message no matter the cost to us. Easter is a reminder of the cost of the message. The cost for God was

enormous — the life of His one and only Son, Jesus Christ. But, it was a cost that God was willing to pay because:

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

This Easter Season, might we not only experience the love, peace, and forgiveness of God in and through Jesus Christ. Might we also be willing to share freely the message of God's love, peace, and forgiveness with sinners like us. If not us, then who? If not now, then when? Pray for God to give you the opportunity to share the message of the cross and the empty tomb. Pray for wisdom to see the opportunities when they come. And, pray for the boldness to proclaim the life-transforming message of Jesus Christ to a lost and dying world.

## Music Ministry 7 Biblical Reasons Why Singing Matters Tom Olson, Author



#### 1. When you sing, you obey.

Singing isn't an option in Scripture. It's a command.

Ephesians 5:18-19: "And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, *addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart...*"

God's people are more than just invited to sing – we are commanded to sing. When we sing, we're doing what God asks of us!

#### 2. When you sing, you dig deep roots in the Word.

"Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly...singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs..." Colossians 3:16

The Apostle Paul lays out this exhortation to let God's Word dwell in us richly, and then, he tells us how to live out that command. The first, of course, is teaching. But the second, is singing!

Singing is one of the two chief ways that the Word of God dwells in us richly.

And, as we observed in the last point singing is a command. But also that this command comes with a promise: as we sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs together, we are promised that the Word of Christ will dwell in us richly – which is what we should crave as believers!

Our singing is more than a warm-up for the sermon or a filler in the service. Colossians 3:16 is clearly laying out for us that: *Singing stands alongside of preaching as one of the two great ways that God has ordained for His Word to dwell RICHLY in each one of us!* 

C.J. Mahaney calls church singing "Take Home Theology," because the best songs we sing together end up serving you as a 3 minute, easily memorizable, deeply biblical summary of important truths from Scripture. Take for example, "In Christ Alone." There, in an easily memorizable form, you've got a thorough theology of the cross of Jesus Christ with clear and practical applications that you can use for your life this week!


