And

PANAMA AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

May 7, 2015

On this first day of the Panama American Chamber of Commerce Trade Mission to Tampa, Florida and in order to further the traditional links of friendship between Tampa and Panama and to affirm their mutual aspiration to work in unison for the benefit of their cities and nations, the Greater Tampa Chamber of Commerce and the Panama American Chamber of Commerce on 7th day of May 2015, do hereby acknowledge and affirm a Cooperative Agreement between the two Chambers.

Both Chambers, on the basis of friendly cooperation, equality and mutual benefit, will continue to develop and strengthen relationships to promote and broaden economic cooperation and cultural exchanges between Tampa, Florida and Panama.

The two Chambers do hereby declare their interest in exploring the establishment of business and trade relations between Tampa and Panama.

In addition, exchanges will be promoted in the area of the arts, such as exhibits, music, dance and other cultural activities.

In addition, exchanges will be promoted in education and the establishment of contacts within educational institutions will be encouraged.

In addition, we declare our intention to promote exchanges in such fields as science and technology, sports, health, youth and any areas that will contribute to the prosperity and the further development of friendship between the people of Tampa, Florida and Panama.
