

The LOGOS Program is a weekly, four-part ministry based on Acts 2:42 for children and adults. We meet from 3:45 - 6:30 on Mondays, Sept. through March in two sessions, Fall and Winter. LOGOS creates an intentional arena where all ages together can learn about, experience, and practice the art of Christian relationships.

BIBLE STUDY



The goal is to nurture children into intelligent and biblically informed discipleship. In small groups, classes use age-appropriate curriculum where they learn what the Bible says about who God is and who they are as children of God.
