

## FLY OF THE MONTH –*EZY Prince*



The EZY Prince is a guide's fly and it is a perfect fly for beginner tiers. Unlike a standard prince the does not include biots for the tail and horns (wing). Rather, the tail and wing are Antron. The EZY Prince is an easy tie especially for those tiers that have difficulty with biots.

### Recipe

Hook: Tiemco 5262 sizes #16 - #8

Bead: Gold appropriate hook size

Thread: Black 6/0

Tail: Brown Antron yarn a hook gap in length

Body: Peacock herl

Rib: Fine copper wire

Wing: White Antron yarn over the body the length of the body

Hackle: Brown

### Tying Instructions:

1. Crush down hook barb.
2. Attach bead and spiral lead wire pushing it forward into the bead to secure it.
3. Attach tying thread behind the lead wire build a thread ramp for a smooth underbody.
4. Wrap the thread rearward to the hook bend.
5. Tie-in the tail extending a hook gap in length.
6. At the tie-in point tie-in the copper rib and 3-5 peacock herls.
7. Wrap the thread forward to behind the bead.
8. Wrap the peacock body forward to behind the bead, tie-off and trim.
9. Wrap the copper rib forward in open spirals to the front of the body, tie-off and trim.
10. Tie-in the Antron wing behind the bead extending rearward the length of the body.
11. Prepare the rooster hackle and tie-in wrapping 2-3 wraps, tie-off and trim.
12. Whip finish.
