Dear Greenwich Resident:

Did you know that the Town of Greenwich owns its own championship golf course named Griffith E. Harris Golf Course located at 1300 King Street? It is an 18 hole, Robert Trent Jones designed course built in 1964 so that Town of Greenwich residents and guests would have an affordable place to enjoy the game since every other course in Town is private and costly. The course, referred to as "The Griff", is recognized as one of the premier public, municipal or private golf courses in the area and has even hosted an official PGA professional event. Greenwich Magazine referred to the course as Greenwich's "hidden gem" in an article it did about the course in August, 2010.
While the course is of championship caliber, each hole has four sets of tees to accommodate golfers of all abilities; from new to excellent golfers. A driving range, putting green and chipping area with sand trap are also on site as well as a full service restaurant (Fairways at The Griff) and a Pro Shop with a resident Pro and assistants that are available for lessons along with a full range of golfing supplies and clothing.
If you are looking for playing partners, there are two men's clubs and two lady's clubs that are very active that you could join. They each hold tournaments almost every week.
