We are recruiting interested teachers for the 2015-16 trial administration of the FSAA-Datafolio.

Eligible teachers will be those supporting students for whom:

- ◇ no formal mode of communication has been established (e.g., limited communication/vocalization—not reliable, inconsistent, and/or unrecognizable);
- ◇ reactions to stimuli are evident (i.e., student only communicates that he or she is hungry, tired, sleepy, uncomfortable, etc.); however, the student does not communicate in other ways; **and/or**
- ◇ prior Florida Alternate Assessment (FAA) results have provided limited information (e.g., student required support to answer all or most FAA items) and/or reflected limited growth within Level I.

If any of these describe your student, you are encouraged to participate in the trial administration of the FSAA-Datafolio for the 2015-16 school year.

FSAA-Datafolio teacher participants will:

- ◇ attend a one-day offsite face-to-face administration training (*mileage and substitute reimbursement provided);
- ◇ provide feedback at various points throughout the process; and
- ◇ ensure a thoughtful process occurs—critical to the success and implementation of the FSAA-Datafolio option in 2016-17.
