Ms. Ponik currently works in the Facility Management Division at the Kennedy Space Center as a program manager. She has worked for NASA for over 25 years. She holds both Chemical and Industrial Engineering degrees. Both of these process-oriented degrees helped her as a Shuttle Logistics Engineer and Shuttle Project manager before her request for a reassignment to the Center Operations organization of her center. There she served in the design and construction office, overseeing multimillion dollar projects. Her unique bigger picture perspective led to her appointment as Master Planner for the center and acting agency master planner. She was consequently appointed the Center Real Property Officer just before the cancellation of the Shuttle program. Based on her visionary, yet practical leadership, Ms. Ponik became the program manager for facility consolidation as the center moved through Shuttle transition and tightening budgets. Ms. Ponik now leads the tactical facility management activity as the spaceport transitions from a single to a multi-user entity; as envisioned when she was Master Planner.
