Committees and Councils: Where do you fit in?

The best way to get involved in your association is to join a committee or council. Each of these groups has fun opportunities and useful information for all their members.

Remodelers Council: The RC meets once per month to provide members with a roundtable discussion forum with others in the industry. They also put on yearly events like the Kick-A\$\$ Cook Off and a Bowling Outing.
Dues: \$75/year

Advanced Building Practices Council: This council meets monthly to provide members with a comprehensive set of tools to build and remodel homes in an environmentally friendly way. Dues: \$75/year
