## Committees and Councils: Where do you fit in?

The best way to get involved in your association is to join a committee or council. Each of these groups has fun opportunities and useful information for all their members.

Remodelers Council: The RC meets once per month to provide members with a roundtable discussion forum with others in the industry. They also put on yearly events like the Kick-A\$\$ Cook Off and a Bowling Outing. Dues: \$75/year

Advanced Building Practices Council: This council meets monthly to provide members with a comprehensive set of tools to build and remodel homes in an environmentally friendly way. Dues: \$75/year

Multifamily Council: Network of developers, builders, owners, managers and associate members with a common goal: the growth, recognition and success of the multi-family industry. This council meets quarterly. Dues: \$100/year + \$25 per 100 units after first 100 units

Professional Women in Building Council: The Professional Women in Building Council is dedicated to supporting the professional development of women in the home building industry. It provides service to the membership through education and training programs that focus on professional and leadership development, networking opportunities and industry-related information. Dues: \$100/year

## Other ways to get involved:

**Associates Council:** This active council plans, promotes, and runs yearly events like the Fall Golf Tournament, Crawfish Boil, Wes Wyman Memorial Fishing Rodeo.
