

FIXED TERM FACULTY POSITIONS (OPEN RANK)

The School of Social Work at the University of Maryland seeks nominations and applications for two non-tenure-track, open rank, full time (10-month) faculty positions. The University of Maryland School of Social Work (UMSSW) MSW program ranks among the top 10% in the U.S. The UMSSW is committed to the well-being of populations and communities at risk and to a racially and culturally diverse faculty and student body. The School of Social Work is part of a dynamic graduate school campus that provides an intellectually exciting, collegial, and supportive environment that fosters interdisciplinary, community-based research and collaborative practice.

We are seeking applicants with social work practice experience and expertise, and the ability to teach in either the clinical practice or macro curricula areas. Applicants for the direct practice and macro practice positions should have demonstrated practice skills and experience in their area of practice. Experience in teaching graduate MSW classes is preferred. In addition to other duties, this non-tenured position is responsible for teaching up to 7 graduate classes per year and a liaison load of 5-6 students, with accompanying committee service. If applicants currently are, or become, involved in externally funded research or technical assistance projects, their teaching requirements may be adjusted with the approval of the Associate Dean.

Applicants must possess an MSW degree from a CSWE accredited School of Social Work. A PhD degree in Social Work or a related area is preferred. Additionally, a minimum of four years post-MSW practice experience is required. Further, the applicant is expected to have the ability to integrate research and scholarship into course development, assignments, and lectures. Knowledge of at least one evidence-based practice is strongly preferred for the clinical position.

Candidates should electronically submit a curriculum vita, a letter outlining teaching interests and experience; teaching evaluations, sample course materials (syllabus, assignments, sample lecture notes; use of online tools); and three letters of reference (with email addresses) to: Megan Meyer, PhD, Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, UM School of Social Work, 525 W. The successful applicant will be offered a three-year contract (with an interim one-year review) that may be followed by additional 3-year and 5-year contracts. Review of applications will continue until position(s) are filled.
