SXU Hosts Fourth Annual Toys for Tots Drive

Chicago (Nov. 12, 2015) With the holiday season right around the corner, Saint Xavier University (SXU) wants to spread a little holiday cheer by proudly collecting toys for the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots Program now until Thursday, Dec. 10.

Since 1947, the U.S. Marine Corps annually collects toys at Christmas for less fortunate children in an effort to send them a message of hope that will help them grow into responsible, productive and patriotic citizens.

In the 63 years since the Toys for Tots program began, the Marines have distributed more than 419 million toys to more than 195 million underprivileged children.

This is the fourth year SXU has participated in this program and will continue to support and distribute toys as Christmas gifts to less fortunate children in the community.
