OUR SERVICES:

- ❖ Founded in 1947, Jewish Family & Child Service (JFCS) delivers essential human services to help alleviate suffering, sustain healthy relationships and support people in times of need.
- ❖ JFCS assisted 2,033 people last year with 12,503 services – converting obstacles into opportunities, hopelessness into hopefulness, and isolation into connection with family and community.
- ❖ Through our Emergency Aid program, we served 1,370 people last year with direct financial assistance, information and referrals, and connection to community resources. Direct aid includes rent and utility assistance, clothing and school supplies, holiday food boxes and gifts, community meals, assistance with vital medical needs, and referrals.
- ❖ Our agency provides state-certified skills training and behavior supports for adults (and now youth!) with developmental disabilities, empowering them to live more independently. We provide education, advocacy and consultation to individuals and their families, serving 304 people last year through all disability support services.
- ❖ JFCS honors its elders by empowering seniors to age in place with dignity and the highest quality of life. Services include homemaker assistance, counseling, case management, workshops on healthy aging, and social activities for more than 100 Holocaust survivors in the community.
- ❖ Over the past year JFCS served 170 individuals, couples, and families through Counseling Services for a variety of issues and concerns. JFCS proudly accepts Medicare and other insurance plans in addition to offering reduced fees for those who otherwise could not access high-quality mental health care.
