

## **General Camp Information**

Register early: Space is limited to facilitate individual attention. Four-person suites will be assigned on a first registered, first accommodated basis.

Housing: Campers will be housed in new suite style residence halls. Amenities include: Air conditioning and a bathroom for every two campers. A pillow, one pillowcase and two sheets will be provided. You will need to bring towels, blankets and washcloths with you. Coin operated washers and dryers are available on each floor in the residence hall.

A **certificate of health** must be presented by each participant

### Directors, Staff, and Guest Lecturers

The SU Sports Camps are proud of the excellent staff and clinicians employed from the college, high school, and NBA ranks to offer superior instruction to our campers. Special guest speakers will be present to lecture and demonstrate the different aspects of basketball. Staff subject to change.

Kristy Trn this winter enters her 17th season as head coach of the SU women's basketball team. The two-time PSAC Western Division Coach of the Year and 2012-2013 PSAC East Division Coach of the Year is the winningest coach in Lady Raider Basketball history. She has guided Shippensburg to 10 conference tournament appearances, and three conference championship games bringing home the title in the 2000 and 2001 seasons. In 2001, Trn's squad advanced to the Final Four of NCAA Division II. Coach Trn has been responsible for recruiting four PSAC Athletes of the Year, five PSAC Freshmen of the Year, 18 PSAC 1st Team All-Conference Selections, 18 PSAC 2nd Team All-Conference Selections, five All Region 1st Team Selections, two State Farm All American selections, six PSAC Winter Top Ten Academic Award Winners, and 16 1,000 point scorers. Coach Trn is a member of both the Shippensburg University Athletic Hall of Fame and Plum High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

Jennifer Scaffidi Grassel is coming off her eighth season as assistant coach for the Shippensburg University women's basketball team. Grassel is a 2005 graduate of SU where she earned a Daktronics, Inc. All-East Region Second Team selection as a senior as well as first team All-Conference. She is currently ranked eighth on the school's career scoring list with 1,583. She is also the only player to total over 100 assists in four-straight seasons and lead the team in assists four consecutive years. Grassel concluded her career with 481 assists.

Prior to Shippensburg, Grassel served as the assistant varsity coach of the Washington Township High School girls basketball team during the 2006-2007 season, helping lead the Minutemaids to a 21-7 record, an Olympic Conference championship and berth in the sectional semifinals.
