

PROGRAM COURSES*

February 9 · Robert Trent, Ph.D.

Strategic Supply Management – This course examines how to achieve supply management excellence and the expanding role played by supply managers toward achieving better performance in a global economy.

February 23 · Gregory Schlegel

Supply Chain Risk Management – This course prepares one to better manage supply chain uncertainty by providing frameworks, models and risk categorizations while providing leading–edge tools and approaches.

March 15 · Paul Myerson

Demand & Supply Chain Planning – This course focuses on how businesses work collaboratively to integrate demand and supply activities giving special attention to critical drivers and key metrics of supply chain performance.

March 29 & 30 · Rich Titus

Lean Six Sigma – This course combines two critical philosophies, lean and six sigma, into a comprehensive framework and presents a set of tools and methodologies that will support continuous improvement efforts.

April 12 · Zach Zacharia, Ph.D.

Integrated Logistics & Transportation Management – This course explores the management of information, products and funds through an extended supply chain with a special focus on transportation and distribution.

April 26 · Robert Trent, Ph.D.

Supply Chain Financial Management – This course stresses the interrelationship between supply chain and financial management techniques when selecting suppliers, managing and developing suppliers, managing international supply chains and managing costs and working capital.

May 3 & 4 · Zach Zacharia, Ph.D.

Capstone Experience: Supply Chain Simulation – This capstone course enables participants to apply and assess their knowledge in a competitive game simulation focused on developing supply chain strategies.

*Courses may be taken individually or the full series completed as a Lehigh University Certificate. The 1-day courses are \$945 and the 2-day courses are \$1,235. The complete Lehigh University Supply Chain Management Certificate Program is \$6,500.
