### MGH&FC's WALK-IN CLINIC NOW OPEN

SHELTON, Wash. – When you need prompt medical attention for a non-life-threatening medical condition, Mason General Hospital & Family of Clinics now has a team of health care providers available at its newly-opened “Walk-in Clinic”.

The Clinic, which opened in early May, is staffed by a team of qualified health care providers and welcomes both current and new patients on a drop-in basis. Located next door to Shelton Family Medicine at 939 Mountain View Drive, the Clinic is open six days a week – Monday through Friday from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m., and on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (closed on Sundays). In order to provide you with medical treatment in the most appropriate care setting, it is important to follow these guidelines:

#### **Non-Emergency Medical Conditions**

For a non-emergency medical condition, start by contacting your primary care physician's office for an appointment. If your regular physician or health care provider is not available when you need to be seen, MGH&FC's Walk-In Clinic can provide care for a non-life-threatening illness or minor injury. Types of non-emergency services provided may include treatment for common illnesses such as colds, flu, ear aches, sore throats, migraines, fever and rashes. The Clinic will also treat minor injuries such as sprains, strains, minor cuts and other minor injuries.
