Utility relocation work could cause delays on SR 3 at Belfair

BELFAIR – Drivers on State Route 3 in Belfair may encounter daytime delays next week.

Lane closure specifics

From 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, Aug. 10-14, crews working for Belfair Water District 1 will move one direction of traffic into the center turn lane from milepost 26.2 to 26.5 roughly from Northeast Belfair Street to Clifton Lane. Left turns from both directions within the work zone will be prohibited.

Drivers can expect up to 15 minute delays, especially during afternoon hours.

Most utility relocation work has been done at night when traffic volumes are low. The utility relocation project has reached a stage where the work must occur during the day.

Drivers can help themselves by planning ahead:

- Plan extra time to reach destinations.
- Travel early in the morning or later in the evening.
- Consider rescheduling discretionary trips.

Drivers can get real-time traffic information on their phone with the WSDOT mobile app and the WSDOT regional Twitter feed. Advance information is also provided on the Olympic Region Weekly Construction and Traffic Updates page.
