
## Spend Your Summer with the Women of the Bible

Powerful, meaningful words spoken by women who pushed the boundaries to be healed, freed, heard and redeemed. Women played important part in guiding the generations in the Old Testament and the Apocrypha and in being a part of Jesus' ministry on earth in the New Testament.
