8th Grade MIT (Madrich(ah)-in-Training) Program

What is a Madrich(ah)? Madrich(ah) or Teacher's Assistant, is a paid position offered to our 9th-12th Grade Students. Madrich(ah) are assigned to work in the classroom, on both Sunday mornings and during our Midweek Program, to assistant teachers and work directly with our younger students (PreK-6th Grade).

Here's how the MIT program works!

- All MIT's must be enrolled in the 8th Grade Kehillah Program. The MIT Program will only meet on Sunday's when the 8th Grade Kehillah Program does NOT have scheduled class. The MIT Program dates are listed below, for full list of 8th Grade classes; please refer to the 8th Grade Kehillah Calendar.
- During the **Fall Semester** MIT's will meet with members of our clergy. During these sessions they will further improve their Hebrew and prayer skills while also learning how to successfully work in a classroom environment.
- Beginning in the Spring Semester, MIT's will get a chance to work in our Religious School Classroom as a Madrich(ah), helping our younger students as they learn their prayers, or participate in Judaic curriculum.
- The cost for the program is nothing! However, if you complete the entire program, both the Fall and Spring semesters, you will qualify to be paid a bonus stipend of \$50. The bonus will be paid to you during the 16/17 Religious School year when you become a 9th grade Madrich(ah)! You must attend at least 80% of the program to qualify for the stipend.
