Fullerton's scope for this Explorer Medium 40 Modified Building included the exterior wall panels, interior wall panels, wood awnings for front and side along with Metal Roof deck. The wood awning at patio and roof system were also provided. They utilized several different exterior finishes on this building; FFS Brickwal, Hardiplank Siding, Metal Siding and Nichiha products.
