Project Summary:

This project was completed in Roseglen, ND by DJR Architects and delivered on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation. Fullerton's scope included the exterior wall panels, interior walls, roof truss system and glazing —field installed. The Whiteshield Headstart utilized cultured stone in Southwest Blend with stone sill in Champagne and Brickwal in Red Blend Velour. FBS assembly option was selected. FBS delivered this building package in February 2015.

Meet or Exceeding Owners Goals, Values and/or Expectations:

DJR Architects were the architects and construction management on this project. They partnered with FBS to speed up the process of construction during the cold North Dakota winter. Assembly of the building package took a little over 4 days. Utilizing FBS, DJR had a one stop shop. DJR didn't have to worry about resourcing a lot of different sub-contractors in North Dakota during the oil boom and could concentrate on other aspects of this project while the building was built in our facility and erected on-site. DJR was able to deliver a high quality building to their customer on-time.
