

Bloomfield PD hiring auxiliary police officers

Interested in a law enforcement career? As a first step, consider becoming an auxiliary officer.

The Bloomfield Police Department will be hiring three auxiliary officers (women and men), with training to begin this summer. To be eligible, you must be 18 years old, a U.S. citizen, and a resident of Bloomfield (or live within 5 miles of Bloomfield if your town has no auxiliary police unit). A high school diploma or GED, valid New Jersey driver's license, and fluent English are required, along with no criminal convictions.



All candidates will be interviewed and background-checked, and must successfully complete a basic auxiliary training course. New officers will receive in-service training with regular Bloomfield officers.
