A three person delegation from Iqrit, a small community of Christians Palestinians who were exiled from their village in 1948 presents their unremitting struggle to return home.



On October 8th, 2015 at 7:00 pm at the Zion Lutheran Church, in Ann Arbor two representatives of the people of Iqrit will tell their story and present an inspiring model for a peaceful ongoing struggle to return home. Iqrit, a community of 1400 Christian Palestinians who yearn to return to their village of origin have become an inspiration for the right of return campaign. Iqrit's youth activists who live in the church,

the only remaining building since the village's demolition Christmas Eve of 1951 propel the far reaching human rights campaign with regional repercussions.
