## **Position Announcement – Communities Coordinator**

The Michigan Immigrant Rights Center (MIRC) is seeking a Communities Coordinator. This is a full-time position based in MIRC's Kalamazoo office. This is a grant-funded position expected to last one year, with the possibility of extension dependent on funding.

The Communities Coordinator focuses on implementing MIRC's Welcoming Michigan initiative in the Kalamazoo area (for more information visit <a href="WelcomingMichigan.org">WelcomingMichigan.org</a>). Responsibilities include coordinating educational and community-building activities in partnership with local governments and community organizations; facilitating local committees of volunteers to implement Welcoming Michigan's goals and activities; conducting outreach and developing relationships with community leaders. This position may involve other work related to Welcoming Michigan as determined by MIRC supervisors.
