WHAS11 and Simmons College are sponsoring a Kentucky US Senate Democrat debate on April 19, 2016. Seven candidates are running in the May 17 2016 primary to represent democrats in the November general election.

The candidates are Jim Gray, Rory Houlihan, Jeff Kender, Ron Leach, Tom Recktenwald, Grant Short and Sellus Wilder. The debate will be held at WHAS11 studios at 520 West Chestnut Street from 8 pm until 9 pm.

WHAS11 will broadcast and stream the debate on WHAS11.com.

Satellite Feed

WHAS11 and Simmons College will provide a satellite feed of the debate for media wishing to downlink it. The coordinates are:

Restrictions

Any media downlinking the U.S Senate Democrat debate feed must abide by the following restrictions:

- Media in the Louisville DMA cannot broadcast or stream on any digital platform audio or video from 7:30 pm until 9:05 pm on April 19, 2016.
- Media outside the Louisville DMA will only be allowed to broadcast the debate live, but will not be allowed to live stream on any digital platform on April 19, 2016.
- Can only use up to 3 minutes of video or audio in total in regularly scheduled newscasts per day.
- Television stations must give verbal and on screen graphic courtesy to WHAS11-TV and Simmons College

- Radio stations must give verbal courtesy to WHAS11-TV and Simmons College
- Websites can post up to 3 minutes of the debate in total with a courtesy to WHAS11-TV and Simmons College printed below the video player.
- Television and Radio stations and Websites are not allowed to use any audio or video from the debate after April 22, 2016.

Media Coverage of the Debate

Media will be allowed to cover the debate, but space is limited. A room will be provided where reporters will be able to watch the debate on TV monitors, but there will NOT be a multi-box for recording.

There will be limited space for parking a satellite or microwave van. We suggest those who use backpack units like TVU's and LiveU's to bring those instead.

Reporters and photographers will only have access to the media room with an official ID from the media outlet you represent. WHAS11 and Simmons College reserve the right to not allow you into the media room if the authenticity of your identification comes into question.
