## French Impressionism Weekend in Seattle

Nov. 7-8, 2015



Join a group of Portlanders for an organized weekend tour of Seattle's French art and culture, Nov. 7-8, 2015. The highlight is a private tour of the *Intimate Impressionism* exhibit at the Seattle Art Museum. The



collection is from the National Gallery of Art in Washington, DC and this is the first time it has *ever* gone on tour. The exhibit features 68 paintings that are considered to be the jewels of French Impressionism, including works of Manet, Renoir, Monet, Boudin, Cézanne, Degas, Gauguin, and van Gogh. The weekend package includes a private museum tour and a group dinner with Jack Cowan, the Honorary Consul of France for the state of Washington. Tour participants will individually arrange their transportation to/from Seattle as well as accommodations; special hotel rates have been arranged as an option for participants.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Participants will arrange their own transportation to Seattle. BoltBus and Amtrak are options. The recommended hotel has on-site parking for those wishing to drive.

1:45pm Meet in Warwick Hotel Lobby (401 Lenora Street). From there we'll walk, cab or Uber over to the Seattle Art

Museum. Linda Witt and staff from the FACC office will lead.

2:30pm Exhibit Private Tour: The tour accommodates English and French speakers. The main tour will be conducted in English by a Seattle Art Museum docent. Those wishing to tune their French can listen to a professional translator who works in tandem with the main docent. The pre-paid tour package covers the price of admission to the museum as well as the private, bilingual small-group tour. After the tour, participants can explore the

museum exhibits at their leisure and return to the hotel to finish check-in and freshen up.

**5:45pm Meet in Hotel Lobby** for walk over to Le Pichet.

**6:15pm Dinner at Le Pichet.** The pre-paid tour package includes \$40 toward dinner at Le Pichet near Pike Place Market, recently nominated as Seattle's Best French

Restaurant for 2015. The group dinner will be attended by the Honorary Consul of France, Jack Cowan. Drinks, food and gratuity above the \$40 pre-paid price will

be paid individually by guests.



SUNDAY, NOV. 8, 2015. Optional breakfast at Brasserie Margaux in the hotel (guests will pay individually). Free time and return to Portland on your own schedule, or arrange with the hotel for another night's stay to explore the area.
