



## Immersion Programs Summer 2015: “French on the Willamette”

Now in its 8th year, the emphasis for the immersion program is on developing fluidity of expression. The program includes targeted exercises on problem areas for Anglophones, with emphasis on current idiomatic expression necessary for spontaneous production in real-life situations. The programs include extensive grammar review, pronouns and the subjunctive. Class sizes are typically 7-10 people. The advanced level also contains a literature component.
