

Tour Organizer Maxine Borcherding:Co-founder of Taste and Compare Academy of Wine, Spirits and Food; and Lead Chef Instructor at the Oregon Culinary Institute

"The journey that led me into a serious study of wine was a teaching assignment. But like Julia Child who famously said, 'I was 32 when I started cooking; up until then, I just ate,' I was 60 when I really began to learn about wine — up until then, I just drank. In self-defense, I took a class; and a funny thing happened. I fell in love with wine, and with everything about wine. I had to learn more."

Since that first class, Chef Borcherding has graduated from the International Sommelier Guild Sommelier Diploma Program, has become a French Wine Scholar through the French Wine Academy, a Spanish Wine Educator through the Wine Academy of Spain, a Wine Location Specialist with distinction from the Center for Wine Origins, and is currently completing her certification as a Master Instructor for the Rhone region through the French Wine Academy.
