Description: This is a class for true beginners or for persons resuming their studies after a long period (and who did not have a significant foundation). The course covers greetings, introductions, nationalities and numbers, expressing preferences, "tu" vs. "vous" forms of address; making a request; inviting, accepting and refusing; telling time; giving your opinion; expressing quantities; foods. Grammar: Verbs "to be", "to have", " to do" and the "-er" conjugation; introduction to pronouns; masculine/feminine adjectives and articles; possessives; alphabet; numbers; the partitive; negation with "ne... pas"; near future tense. Phonetics: [i], [y], [u] & intonation, elision, rhythm.

Description: This course will cover material in both the Latitudes 101 & Latitudes 102 classes. Communication: Greetings, introductions, nationalities and numbers, expressing preferences, "tu" vs. "vous" forms of address; making a request; inviting, accepting and refusing; telling time; giving your opinion. Grammar: Basic irregular verbs; 'er' verbs; introduction to pronouns adjectives and articles; possessives; interrogative forms; alphabet; numbers; "ne pas"; near future tense; "il y a"; direct object pronouns; introduction to passé composé with "avoir"; idiomatic expressions. Phonetics: Intonation, rhythm, elision, vowel sounds, final sounds, some consonant sounds, liaison. Appropriate for those who have had a little French, but don't feel prepared to start right off with 102.

Grammar: "Il y a"; disjunctive pronouns; interrogative "quel, quels..."; questions with "est-ce que"; verbs: vouloir, pouvoir, venir, savoir, connaître, and the "-ir"conjugation; direct object pronouns; introduction to passé composé with "avoir". Phonetics: "la liaison"; silent final consonants; sounds [s], [z], [f],[ʒ].

Description: This class will be based on the reading and discussion of "La petite fille de Monsieur Linh". This fiction was published by the award winning novelist and film-maker Philippe Claudel (born 1962) in 2005. He is also the author of Brodeck's Report. The novel tells the story of Monsieur Linh, who arrives on a refugee boat from Asia, having lost his beloved son and daughter-in-law during a recent war. He is lonely and confused, without the language of his new country, where everything is foreign to him. His only consolation is his baby girl, 'Sang diû', who he saved and who is now his sole reason for living... and then he encounters Monsieur Bark. Neither speaks the other's language, but Monsieur Bark is sympathetic to the foreigner's need to care for the child. Recently widowed and equally alone, he is eager to talk, and Monsieur Linh knows how to listen. The two men share their solitude, and find friendship in an unlikely dialogue between two very different cultures.

Description: This class will analyze the esthetic and thematic choices of some notable French directors. Certain films that are rare will only be available in French with French subtitles. Covering just over a century, the history of the "7th art" can be divided into 7 sections averaging 15 years each, separated by transition periods. These sections were selected because of the historically significant events that occurred during each respective time period. Students will study the evolution of French cinema as it relates to domestic and international political and social change. Through watching selected film extracts, students will observe a variety of unique cultural and linguistic characteristics. Descriptive essays and summaries will be written weekly.

Description: This class will be based on the reading and discussion of the book "Une Vie Française" de Jean-Paul Dubois. Jean-Paul Dubois' book deftly covers 50 years in the life of a man in the heart of a French community that starts with Charles de Gaulle and ends with Jacques Chirac. The book is a successful mix of anecdotes from everyday life and historical moments in France (May 1968, French family life, the death of Franco, first love...). Jean-Paul Dubois describes half a century of French politics in a humorous and disenchanted style. From tears to laughter, from life to death Dubois offers us a captivating novel. Jean-Paul Dubois was born in Toulouse in 1950 and lives there currently. Author of numerous novels he won the French Television prize for « Kennedy et moi » (Seuil, 1996) and the « Prix Femina » for Une Vie Française.
