**Ball Drop**

**CONTEST RULES**

The Santa Fe Texas Education Foundation's Ball Drop is presented for the benefit of the Santa Fe Texas Education Foundation (SFTXEF), a charitable organization under 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Eligible entrants purchasing a ticket or tickets and making a donation of \$5 per golf ball or 5 golf balls for \$20 will be entered in the Ball Drop and assigned a numbered golf ball that matches the number on their ticket or online receipt. Only 2,000 balls will be available for purchase and sold on a first come first serve basis. Any unsold golf balls become property of the SFTXEF. The Ball Drop entry ticket or online submission form must be completed with all required information, assigned numbers are printed on the ticket stub retained by the entrant, as well as on the portion of the ticket kept by the SFTXEF. Eligible entrants may purchase more than one numbered golf ball and need not be present on Saturday, May 2, 2015 to win. Tickets must be purchased by Saturday, May 2, 2014 at 11:00 pm to qualify. Participants must be a USA residents of 18 years of age and older as of date of entry. The dropping of the golf balls will take place on Saturday, May 2, 2015, between approximately 1:00 and 2:00 pm, weather permitting. 2,000 consecutively numbered golf balls will be dropped over a set area at the Galveston County Fairgrounds at #10 Jack Brooks Park, Hwy 6, Hitchcock, Texas. Golf balls will be provided by the SFTXEF and shall remain the property of the SFTXEF.

Prior to the Ball Drop, a predetermined number between 1 and 2,000 will be randomly chosen by Grand Prize Promotions (serving as an independent 3<sup>rd</sup> party) and mailed to the SFTXEF in a sealed envelope. 2,000 balls will be dropped over a determined circle, of 10 inches diameter, on the ground. The 10 balls that land in or closest to the predetermined circle will have a chance to win the Grand Prize of a new car, if one of the 10 participant's ball numbers matches the predetermined number in the sealed envelope. If 1 of the 10 golf balls wins the grand prize, the remaining 9 balls will be eligible for a consolation prize; otherwise, all 10 participants will be eligible for a consolation prize. The Grand Prize is sponsored by Ron Carter Autoland. The grand prize winner may choose among the new General Motors vehicles at their facility valued up to \$25,000. The consolation prizes will be determined as follows: the eligible balls (the balls that landed in or closest to the circle) will be placed in a container and randomly chosen. The consolation prizes will be drawn in this order:

The winner will be announced immediately following the ball drop. The winner will be notified in person, via email and/or phone. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.
