CRE announces pro bono consulting awardees for the 2016 CRE Rising Fund.

New York, NY - Today Community Resource Exchange (CRE) announced the five nonprofit awardees of the CRE Rising Fund, a pro bono consulting initiative now in its second year. Common Wise, Destination Tomorrow, Grace Outreach, The Knowledge House, and Turning Point will each receive customized consulting services from CRE to strengthen their organizations and serve their communities more effectively.

“We are delighted to support our second group of CRE Rising Fund awardees,” said Katie Leonberger, President and CEO of CRE.

“Each of the selected nonprofit recipients is working to meet a compelling need in their community.

“These organizations are embedded in their neighborhoods, understand the people they serve, and are hard at work leveraging limited resources to create real and lasting impact.”

The awardees cover a broad range of impact areas, from services for Muslim women and children and the LGBTQ community, to entrepreneurship and emerging technology education programs.

The consultation projects will kick off in July, starting with a needs assessment period between CRE and the awardee.

“We customize all of our offerings to match our clients’ needs,” Ms. Leonberger said.

“After we have scoped the project, our awardee organizations will receive services focusing on their individual needs through the summer and fall of 2016.”

This is the second year for the CRE Rising Fund, a program which links CRE’s pro bono consulting history with its ongoing commitment to support small nonprofits that are driving change in their communities.

“We are a nonprofit ourselves, and have always come from a place of partnership with organizations across the city,” Ms. Leonberger said.

“The CRE Rising Fund helps to ensure that all nonprofits have access to training and consulting support – something we are excited to continue and grow going forward.”
