

## Informational Memo - Entry Plan Update

The Central Office administrative team has thoroughly reviewed the seven ambitious opportunities derived during the Entry Plan process and determined where these opportunities would best fit into the current strategic plan.

- 1. Student Growth Model
- 2. Special Education
- 3. Professional Development System
- 4. Kindergarten Day
- 5. STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math)
- 6. 21st Century Experiential Learning
- 7. Facilities/Environmental Design

The team also evaluated the current strategic plan goals and identified those that were completed. Goals were also reviewed for continuation while other goals were determined to be "everyday business." These goals were no longer deemed strategic, however, do represent the typical work or process of the District.

Revised strategic goals for the 2015-2016 were prioritized and reviewed with building administrators. The administrative team also analyzed the volume of work to ensure that there are fewer goals so the workload would be conducive for quality process and products.

A small representative team of staff, parents, and administrators has been identified to wordsmith the District's Shared Vision, based on the feedback from many constituents. This process will take place over the next two weeks.

A revised strategic plan and draft Shared Vision will be presented to the School Board at the June 9, 2015, meeting.
