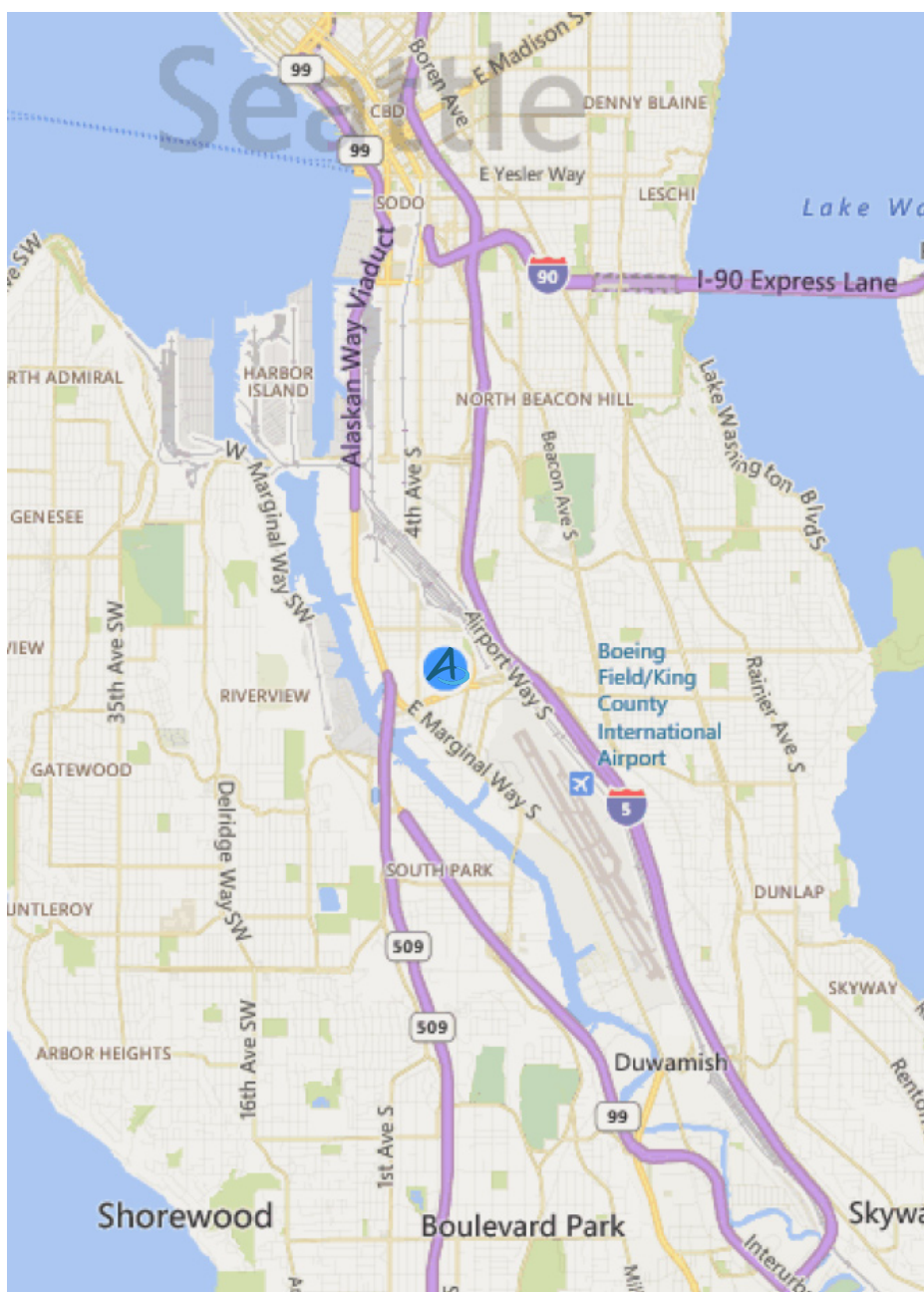
Take Exit # 162 for Corson Ave S
