President's Comments

What is the difference between doctors and lawyers? Lawyers think they know everything, and doctors know they know everything.

Like many jokes, this one has a germ of truth -- at least with regard to lawyers. Much of our work as lawyers is dedicated to cleaning up other people's messes. We are accustomed to confronting an ugly situation that somebody else has created, figuring out what needs to be done, and then trying to make it right. We want to think of ourselves as superheroes who can handle any situation and who know better than anyone else (including sometimes opposing counsel and the judge) what needs to be done. But sometimes that lawyerly self-confidence backfires.

According to studies, about 15% of the lawyers in the United States have a problem with substance abuse, which is actually higher than the 10% rate in the general population. We are not immune to these problems here in Mobile; our legal community has recently witnessed some tragic losses, as well as damage to the public, as a result of substance abuse problems.

As you may know, the Alabama State Bar has an award-winning Lawyer Assistance Program. And our local bar is taking steps as well. The **MBA LAWYER ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE** has recently set up a help line so that any lawyer can call the bar headquarters anonymously and be given the names and phone numbers of committee members whom they can contact for assistance or advice. Even if the caller chooses to give his or her name to the committee member, the discussions are completely confidential. There is also an **AA/NA** meeting for lawyers which meets at the **CHRIST EPISCOPAL**

Browsing the Bar – With Barbara

HAPPY NEW YEAR! We here at the **MBA HEADQUARTERS** have begun 2011 with both feet in the running position – much to do, new officers, new committees, new sections, dues statements, new LRS panel, end of year finances, 2011 budget. ..shall I go on?

I came across a little bit of trivia that I want to share with you ... The symbol “&” is called an ampersand in English and represents the word “and”. His system contained more than 5,000 symbols, yet, the ampersand is the only figure to have survived history. Why this figure survived while the others disappeared is unexplainable, but it is one of the few symbols that are readily understood in numerous languages.

CHURCH parish house at 5:30 p.m. on the first and third Thursdays of each month; again, as provided by AA guidelines, all meetings are confidential.

The members of our local **LAWYER ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE** believe lawyers are reluctant to seek help because they are afraid they will endanger their law licenses. That is not true at all; at both the local and state levels there is a barrier between the assistance programs and the **OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL**. Seeking help does not involve disciplinary action. The **OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL** can refer people to the state’s **LAWYER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**, but it doesn’t work the other way.

Our local committee’s members also say it’s a big mistake to think “this can never happen to me” or “nobody I am associated with would let that happen.” Within a law firm, it is not a solution to say that the firm will just “get rid of the lawyer.” By the time a problem surfaces, the affected lawyer may have already caused substantial problems ranging from unbecoming conduct to malpractice or worse. He has certainly not always given the firm’s clients his best. Professional considerations aside, our local committee relates that the majority of lawyers with substance abuse problems who do not get help eventually confront loss of family and friends, bankruptcy, criminal and licensure issues, or death.

Sometimes we lawyers need to sit back and realize we aren’t always in control. We may think we can handle a potential substance abuse problem by ourselves, but that’s just not the case. There is lots of good and caring help available at both the local and state bar levels (and monetary assistance from the state bar). The bottom line is that we lawyers need to take care of ourselves and each other just as conscientiously as we take care of our clients.



SIGNIFICANT DECISIONS

Overruling *Ex parte Ackles*, 840 So.2d 145 (Ala.2002), the Supreme Court in *Ex parte Collins*, No. 1091310 (Ala., November 24, 2010), held that, notwithstanding the provisions of Ala. Code §6-6-640, the requirement that petitions for writ of certiorari and other extraordinary writs be verified was a procedural and not a jurisdictional requirement, and, thus, could be waived by failure to assert, could not be raised at any stage of a proceeding, and could be remedied by a timely amendment to the petition.

In *Baldwin Mutual Insurance Co. v. Edwards*, No. 1090944 (Ala., November 24, 2010), the Supreme Court held that Ala. Code § 6-5-641, when a class action plaintiff filed an amended pleading revising the class definition, the trial court was required to conduct an evidentiary hearing before it could certify a class under the revised definition.

In *Natures Way Marine, LLC v. Dunhill Entities*, LP, No. 1090421 (Ala., November 19, 2010), the Supreme Court dismissed an appeal taken pursuant to a Rule 54(b) certification on the ground that the order certified was inherently not final. The order involved a summary judgment entered in favor of a defendant on a plaintiff's mechanics' lien enforcement claim, where the defendant had asserted a counterclaim for breach of contract arising out of the plaintiff's work. Because the summary judgment was only as to the plaintiff's claim and due to the inherent overlap between the claim and the counterclaim, the Court held that the summary judgment was inherently non-final and could not be certified under Rule 54(b).

VOLUNTEER LAWYER PROGRAM

Equal justice under law is not just a caption on the facade of the Supreme Court building. It is perhaps the most inspiring ideal of our society . . . It is fundamental that justice should be the same, in substance and availability, without regard to economic status. - U.S. Supreme Court Justice Lewis Powell, Jr.

How many New Year's resolutions have you broken already? Please don't ask me, because my track record on resolutions is abysmal year after year. Yet, I still love this time of year because it forces me to reflect upon and celebrate the past and future. So let's reflect upon the MBA Volunteer Lawyer's Program's accomplishments in the past year and our plans for the future.

In 2010, VLP referred 895 cases to **YOU**. **YOU** served approximately 6457 low income individuals in Mobile County, who would not have had access to our legal system if it were not for **YOU**. Approximately 423 of **YOU** accepted cases this past year, and over 500 of **YOU** closed cases, for a total amount of 3282 volunteer hours. Whether **YOU** know it or not, **YOU** met a significant milestone this past year – in 2010, VLP reached over 30,000 hours of attorney contribution since the program's inception in 1987, when some of **YOU** had the forethought to create the program through a bar committee. Approximately 70% of **YOU** are VLP lawyers, which is a figure that far exceeds the national average and continues to amaze other local bar associations across Alabama. **YOU** also contributed over \$50,000 to the Mobile VLP, which is our best year yet for private bar fundraising. **YOU** obviously understand it is when the economy is at its worst, that the VLP client population needs **YOU** most. Because of **YOUR** support, VLP's staff of five was able to fully launch the online intake system in October, conduct Wills for Heroes clinics, and host its annual fundraiser, Broadway Briefs. Thank **YOU**!

VLP is on the move for the coming year. There have been discussions at the state level about exploring a regional delivery model of pro bono services, and **YOUR** VLP is taking the lead in that investigation. We will ask some of **YOU** to help us answer the important questions about this opportunity before we move forward. We also have the opportunity to partner with DHR to create a new panel of volunteer attorneys to assist foster care parents who wish to adopt children in their care. We will be asking **YOU** to help.

If **YOU** have not noticed, this article is about **YOU**. **YOU** have certainly heard it before and **YOU** undoubtedly know it, but our VLP is nationally recognized and by far the best in the State. When others ask about our secret (and they do), I tell them about **YOU**. VLP's success is truly the result of **YOU** deciding that it is your professional responsibility to give back to the bar, the profession, and the community. Thank **YOU** again for your commitment to VLP and the low income citizens of Mobile County.

We will highlight **YOUR** many contributions over the coming year. In the first installment, we celebrate the work of Russell Bergstrom. Thank you Russ, and thank all of **YOU**.

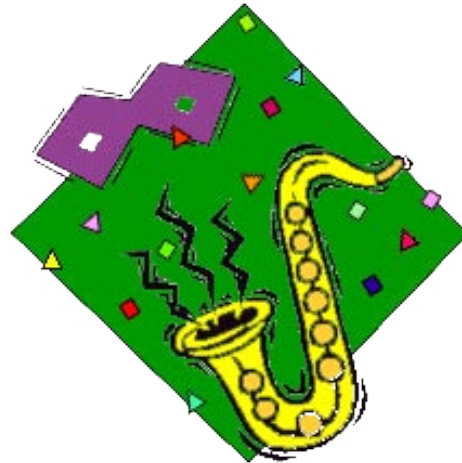

MOBILE COUNTY COURT MEDIATION PROJECT

JUDY KEEGAN, DIRECTOR FOR THE ALABAMA CENTER FOR DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ACDR), has started a project in selected counties in Alabama to bring mediation to the forefront of all eligible suits that are filed in either the District or Circuit court. The goal is to make filers aware that mediation is available for these suits. A form will be provided to all appropriate filers, and subsequent defendants, stating that mediation is available as an option to try and settle their differences. In Small Claims court the mediation will be provided at no cost to the parties. In District and Circuit Courts there could (and probably will) be a charge involved by the mediator(s).

JUDY KEEGAN envisions that the attorneys that are on the ACDR roster of approved mediators would volunteer to be placed on the Mobile roster to provide the pro bono hours for District Court. This would provide a vehicle for the state roster attorneys to achieve their ten hours of pro bono work, provide a service to the courts and to the community and relieve an estimated one to two hours from the District Court docket each day.
