

Need a laptop? Check out a lap top at the Tech Desk, for use in the library for up to one hour. Borrowers need a library card in good standing and a valid Drivers' License.

Need a Meeting Room? Log on to www.scottpublib.org, Click on "Room Reservations". A free service, you need a library card in good standing to request a room. First time users submit a valid e mail address to create an account. Open the verification e mail to activate your account, then follow the prompts to reserve the room that best fits your needs. Requesting Interlibrary Loan Books It is possible to check out a book the library does not own. Librarian Mike Key explains how:

What kind of barbeque sauce goes best with roasted aardvark? Is a vinegar-based sauce the way to go? Or should you slather the beast with a garlic-mango-thyme infused mustard slurry? *Delectable Aardvark: The Unassuming Other White Meat* by chef Bay Lief Buchanan is the book with all the answers, BUT Scott County Library doesn't own a copy. What do you do?

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) to the rescue! This free service lets you borrow up to three books at a time from another Kentucky library, or out of state libraries. It typically takes one to four weeks for your book to arrive. Return it to SCPL, and we send it back for you.

How do you request ILL books? There are now two ways. The newest and most convenient way is to fill out an online ILL form. Log on to www.scottpublib.org. Click open the SERVICES tab in the top banner. In the dropdown menu, click on INTERLIBRARY LOAN. Navigate to the bottom, then click open the link for INTERLIBRARY LOAN ONLINE. Fill in the form and submit. Staff will either phone or email you when your books arrive. You can still request ILL books the traditional way by filling out a paper form at the library's Information Desk. Any fiction requests must have a publication date that is at least one year old. Non fiction requests must have a publication date that is at least six months old. You need to be 18 years or older and have a valid SCPL card to use this service.
